## How are GPCP appointments billed?

Appointments are billed as office visits with a specialty provider. This covers the time and expertise provided by the specialist during your visit.

## What is my expected out of pocket cost?

Visits are typically covered with a specialty copay for in-network insurance plans. However, each insurance plan is different, so in some cases a co-insurance or deductible may apply.

## How do I confirm my coverage for the visit?

Contact your insurance carrier for a personalized estimate. The insurance representative may ask for certain information about the visit; this is provided below.

First appointment: 99205 and 99417 (2 units)

Follow-up appointment: 99215 and 99417 (up to 4 units)

### **Diagnoses**

Your personal or family history of cancer (ex: mother had breast cancer)
Your personal or family history of a gene mutation (ex: brother has Lynch syndrome)
Your personal or family history of colon polyps (ex: I had 20 pre-cancerous polyps)

## Does this include genetic testing?

Genetic test charges are separate from office visit charges. If you choose to have genetic testing, your GPCP provider will discuss the process in more detail. If required, prior authorization for testing is coordinated directly between the laboratory and the insurer. You may also contact your insurer to ask about your plan's cancer genetic testing coverage policy.
